Terrain, map and courses

Terrain

Kubija (sprint): the tracks run along the tracks of the Kubija sports center, the landscape is forested, with small differences in height, close to the city with a dense network of roads.

Haanja (middle and long distances): the tracks run on the trails near the Haanja ski stadium. The maximum height difference is 40 m. There are both forested and open areas in the terrain.
